Unit of work with a focus on an experimental and painterly approach to creating a variety of image making techniques. Students introduced to the fundamentals of wet and digital photography in a studio context using readily available and inexpensive materials.

Building technique and confidence through investigations of Renaissance and Contemporary approaches to painting. A Preliminary unit of work that focuses on developing skills in traditional and contemporary painting techniques and materials through the study of related artists and art making practice.

Decked Out Stage 5: Year 9 Visual Arts
